Preparation

 - Deciding a goal and making a plan might take some time, if the children are to stay engaged you will need to keep the process moving.
 - But don't jump ahead and present a goal and how it is going to be achieved, all the family should feel part of the journey.
- Think about the different ages and capabilities of your children and different tasks that they might be able to undertake to contribute to the process.

Involving the family

- Get the whole family together to discuss a goal and how you are going to achieve it.
- Help all the children to research how much reaching your goal will cost. Use our checklists to prompt you and make sure that you deal in facts, not hype or hearsay.
- Your ideal might be too expensive, so compromise and agree a goal that everyone is excited about and is achievable.
- Once you've agreed what you are going to do, everyone should sign their name (or make a scribble!) at the bottom of the checklist to show that they are committed to the process.
